

**Rocky Mountain Division SCCA  
Baby Grand Rules  
Effective January 1, 2008**

For SCCA purposes these rules are grandfathered through 2011.

1. Baby Grand is a regional-only class for Baby Grand stockcars competing in SCCA-sanctioned regional club racing events in the Rocky Mountain Division.

2. Baby Grand stockcars are tube-frame, fiberglass-body 2/3-scale replicas of Nextel Cup stockcars manufactured by Baby Grand Manufacturing, Inc. or its successor Baby Grands, Inc. and sanctioned by the Miniature Motorsports Racing Association (MMRA).

4. Cars must comply with the current MMRA Baby Grand Rulebook as published by the Miniature Motorsports Racing Association including all specifications for cars competing in SCCA-sanctioned road-racing events referred to and contained in the current MMRA Baby Grand Rulebook. Baby Grand competitors must be in possession of the current MMRA Baby Grand Rulebook at all competitions. It is recommended that the Baby Grand cars be grouped with cars of similar weight, configuration, and speed potential. Modifications outside of those permitted in the current MMRA Baby Grand Rulebook shall render the car ineligible for SCCA Club Racing competition.

a. Specifications for cars competing in SCCA-sanctioned road-racing events referred to and contained in the current MMRA Baby Grand Rulebook include, but in case of Rulebook update will not be limited to:

12.7	Windshield thickness
12.22	Bumper modifications for towing
12.24	Brake lights
13.10	Fire bottle system

5. The identification marking for cars competing in the Baby Grand class, per GCR 9.3.28., shall be "GTB".

6. Cars shall display the SCCA logo per GCR 9.3.28., but are not required to cover any logos associated with Baby Grand or stockcar race sanctioning bodies.
