Professionals do all the emergency training in fire and rescue techniques. The Saturday sessions are indoors, the Sunday training takes place out of doors. Weather could cause schedule adjustments. Wear comfortable, non-flammable clothes (non-nylon), preferably old clothes, since practice will likely be dirty. Coffee and donuts will be available in the morning. Space limitations limit the sessions to 50 students. Rental of the facilities and the use of the fire extinguisher chemicals dictate that a fee of \$20 be charged each student.
